Forms of intercultural communication




Verbal communication

it is represented by the information transmitted with the help of words specific to a language



Paraverbal communication

represents the totality of the signals and stimuli transmitted through the tone, volume and rhythm of the voice




Nonverbal communication

represents the totality of stimuli and signals transmitted through posture, physiognomy, facial expressions, gestures and gaze.
